

Faculty Facts from the HEPC / CCTC 2010 Report Card

- Faculty research grants and contracts increased to \$243,433,000, up over 89 million dollars in the past four years.
- Undergraduate enrollment increased to 55,945, up 7.1% since 2005.
- Baccalaureate degrees awarded increased to 8,269, up 4.3% since 2005.
- Certificates and degrees conferred by Major have increased to 12,196, up 5% since 2005.
- Career Technical Certificates conferred by CTCs increased to 509, up 52.4% since 2005.
- Career Technical Associate Program completers increased to 1,900, up 5.1% since 2005.
- Adult Education enrollment increased to 19,476, up 8.5% since 2005 in 4-year institutions; up 21.5% in community colleges.
- Graduate enrollment increased to 13,112, up 11.2% since 2005.
- Licensure and certification examination pass rates have increased in Dietetics to 88.6%, in Nursing to 91.2%, in Social Work to 77.1%, in Cytotechnology and Dental Hygiene to 100% pass rates, in Teacher Education Praxis II pass rates at 92.2%.
- Faculty salaries for fall 2009, in all categories, fall below the national average.
