Governor Tomblin's budget recommendations for FY 2013 are shown below and are compared against the higher education appropriations request. If adopted by the Legislature as presented, the combined HEPC and CTCS systems will see increases of \$5.5 million in FY 2013.

The Governor's recommendations for higher education included new funding for PEIA - \$1,027,003, West Virginia University School of Public Health - \$1,000,000, General Operations - \$1,500,000 (to be allocated by the HEPC), and Community College Workforce Development - \$2,000,000.

HEPC

Within the HEPC central office, the Governor added funds for PEIA. There were funds for both the REMI and Perinatal projects that were transferred to the HEPC budget last year and remain in the current recommended budget.
