The course is designated as 3 hours but the syllabus shows only 1 hour. More explanation needed. 3. Multiple questions as to the content of this course, specifically, is it research-based? 4. Is this course a Senior Seminar for International Perspectives or is it a Senior Seminar for Languages? <br> The committee needs clarity on what is encompassed by International Perspectives to better evaluate this course addition. It is highly recommended that a faculty member or Chair of that department attend the next EPC meeting with the application to clarify the committee's questions. |
