MARK CARDWELL

Mark Cardwell Named Coach of the Year

A. M. Rivera, Jr., of the Pittsburgh Courier stated in his article in the latest edition of the paper that of the coaches and sports writers he interviewed on the subject, all were in unanimous agreement that the mythical accolade designating the coach of the year should be conferred upon Mark H. Cardwell for outstanding achievement in the world of sports for 1948.

The brains behind the West Virginia State College Yellowjackets, Coach Cardwell is undisputed candidate for the title. His cagers won the CIAA championship and his gridders have just recently earned the conference football championship.

In 1945, Cardwell came to coach at West Virginia State College, his alma mater and finished in second place for two straight gridiron campaigns.

Mark Cardwell played varsity ball at West Virginia State from 1921 to 1925, during which time he was elected captain of the All-American team for 1923 and 1924.

Before coming to West Virginia State College, Cardwell was coach for the Kelley Miller High School of Clarksburg, West Virginia, where he was equally successful.
