


Realizing the integral part that athletics play in a college life, as students we feel that our college life has largely been enhanced by the superior showing of our teams in Negro collegiate sports.

These teams, composed of our schoolmates and classmates have not only excelled as individual players but as a unit, displaying valor, fidelity and sportsmanship that has gained for them recognition as champions in their respective fields of competitive sports.

To the coach, we lift our hats. Not only for the production of championship teams but for the principles and manners endowed in his systematized method of fair play. Through this type of coaching, our teams have developed champions and were taught the intrinsic value of guidance, objective thinking and leadership.

Coach Mark H. Cardwell came to this college from Kelly Miller High School of Clarksburg, West Virginia, in 1945. There he had made a name for himself as an outstanding coach, by winning eighty per cent of his games in both football and basketball during his twenty years there as head coach. The five years at this college have been equally as impressive, he has produced both championship football and basketball teams, had a winning streak of thirty-two consecutive games and was the only undefeated college quintet in America with twenty-three wins and no defeats in 1948. It was on these merits in '48 that our team was crowned the Tournament, C. I. A. A. and National champs and the honor of "Coach of the Year" was bestowed upon our coach.

When we look at our athletic scroll of honor, we see as bulwarks on our basketball team the names of Clark, Lloyd, Wilson, Gillum, Enty, Nunn, Simms and Rockhold. In our Gridiron hall of fame, are the names of Bailey, Harris, Burney, Christian, Starling, Davis, Fairfax, Gillum, Graves, Green, Walton, Majett, Bucklen, Thomas, Dillard, Clark and Wickliffe. Several of these names are also found on the All-Conference and All-American teams rosters.

Congratulations!! You have done well. May your success serve as an everlasting heritage for those who seek recognition in the world of sports and you shall long be remembered as stalwarts at this college in years to come.







# The History

We were approximately seven hundred strong with an increased number of veterans taking advantage of the G. I. Bill of Rights.

Living to a pattern, we started with our best foot forward by participating in the freshman initiation. We performed tasks of shining shoes, collecting waste paper, mopping floors, and ironing. We sang, entertained, bowed, and greeted our "distinguished upper classman" as Miss or Mister. Wearing "dogtags" and "beanies", we learned the Alma Mater and elected class officers. As president we chose Edward Brown, vice-president Thomas Patterson, secretary Dolly Jones, and treasurer, Barbara Hale.

We lived on a nervous tension and were constantly harassed by the upperclassmen until finally "Homecoming" arrived. To top off the event, we presented a big talent show, filled with comical acts and weird dances. At the conclusion we tossed our freshman caps into the air and kept our "dogtags" as souvenirs. At last we were integrated into college life and no longer conspicuous as a "dog" or "dogette". We pushed forward to attain a place in the academic and extra curricular activities of the school.



Dignified Juniors, we termed ourselves in September of 1948. Many of us were members or aspirants of some Greek organization. Most of us were too busy to bother with hazing the freshmen as we were now concerned with reaching that goal—graduation. As juniors, we elected as president Robert B. Elmore, vice-president Lucius A.
